So I was going to order some RS6 liners but the dealership was out of stock and said it would be at least a mc to get them in...so I went to home depot and walked around until I found the perfect materials to use. I ender with a 24"x24" heating vent.




Well then I went to work...

I ended up bolting it up to the plastic at about 7 places and also put down a bead of silicone to help keep it tig everything was installed I checked the clearance between the tire and the wheel liner, it ended up being the stock. So I wont have an rubbing issues.
